***4th-8th Weights:*** 60, 65, 70, 75, 80, 85, 90, 95, 100, 105, 110, 120, 130, 140, 150, 170, HWT

Weigh-ins Sunday from 11:30 -12:30 Wrestling begins around 1:30 pm

- Entry Fee: \$400 per team, please call to get signed up
- **FULL REFUNDS** if event is cancelled
- 17 weight classes; up to 20 competitors on a team
- Competitors must weigh in as a team
- Competitors must weigh in wearing a singlet and will receive 2lb at the scale
- Competitors may bump up a maximum of 2 weight classes
- 5 mats will be available. Extra exhibition matches will be available for both sessions.
- Medals and stocking hats for 1<sup>st</sup> place dual finishers. Dual team medals for 2<sup>nd</sup> thru 4<sup>th</sup> place finishers.

Depending on the number of teams we will have pool play, then cross bracket. All wrestlers will get 4 matches or more. Tie breaker is head to head, most team points, least points giving up, falls, coin flip.

Match length will be 1:00 – 1:00 – 1:00 K-4 youth division.

Match length will be 1:30 – 1:00 – 1:00 4th -8th division

No outside food or drink will be permitted for fans. Concessions will be available on site. Wrestlers are permitted to bring in a small cooler for their food and drinks.

You may bring in your own lawn chairs. Chairs will also be available.

Cost will be \$10.00 at the door. Anyone under the age of 5 will get in free. Please limit the number of spectators to no more than 2 per wrestler.

Each team gets two free coach passes.

Each team must provide a score table worker who will receive a free pass.

**COVID Precautions:**

- We will be following current state COVID 19 guidelines
- Everyone will be required to wear a face covering
- Wrestlers will not be required to wear a face covering while competing. When not competing face masks are required.
- Anyone with a temperature of 99.1 or above is asked to not enter the Community Centre.
- Hand sanitizer will be available.. However it is encouraged that everyone bring their own. Also please bring along your own personal sanitizer and wipes.
