POINT SYSTEM FOR SELECTING JUNIOR HIGH COACH OF THE YEAR

An outstanding coach from the Junior High level shall be selected by first being nominated by a member of the IWCOA and then accumulating points from a criteria obtained from a data sheet completed by the nominating coach. The Junior High coach accumulating the greatest number of points is the year's coach for outstanding contributions to a wrestling program at the Junior High level. If the program is run by a team of coaches, then the team may be nominated, however the coach with the greater number of years should be used in totaling criteria.

1. Number of years involved in wrestling (coaching, officiating, etc.) Receive (3) points for the first five years of service and (1) additional point for every additional two years.
2. Number of years as just a junior high coach. Receive (3) points for first five years of service, and (1) point for each additional two years.
3. Number of years at nominating coaches' junior high. (3) points for first five years, and (1) additional point for each additional year.
4. Number of wrestlers recruited into wrestling program. (10) Points for the first ten wrestlers, and (1) point for each additional four wrestlers.
5. Number of wrestlers who stay wrestling. The total number of junior high wrestlers divided into the number of ninth and tenth graders presently out for wrestling will produce a percentage. 94% and equals (10) points, 88-93% equals (8) points, 80-88 % equals (6) points, 72-79% equals (4) points and 65-71% equals (2) points.
6. Outstanding Alumnus (1-10 points) the points awarded for this segment of the data sheet to be determined by the IWCOA Vice President.
7. Contribution to the total program (1-15 points). The points awarded for this segment of the data sheet are to be determined by the IWCOA Vice President.
